Erection of stable block, construction of sand school and provision of hardstanding.

Cllr Maher presented the plans to the meeting. These were scrutinized.

The meeting noted that this application for a large new stable block, sand school and associated hard standing is against the SD National Park policies DC1 and DC2, members felt that this was equestrian, and therefore not agriculture and too large to be considered recreational, neither did it have regard to the local character being of a very significant size.

Members were of the opinion that contrary to the application, the size of the building would be a very ugly building that spoils a pleasant view, especially when viewed from the National Park, i.e. from the Water Brooks or the South Downs. Also, the position of the proposed building would eliminate any view of the National Park from neighbouring properties; Hardham House, Moseley's Barn and The Piggeries.

Members also felt that the dimensions were more in keeping with a commercial enterprise, but no commercial usage is mentioned in the application, members thought that the size was excessive for personal usage. However, considering the applicant's riding instructor qualifications, members thought that it would be used commercially to run an equestrian establishment.

Members raised concerns regarding increase of vehicle activity accessing the property on a dangerous hidden bend, especially by horse boxes and towed horse-trailers which would find the tight turn hard in one maneuver.

RESOLVED: To object to SDNP regarding this application with regards to SDNP

policies DC1 and DC2, and the overall size and position of the

proposed building.

Cllr Nelson advised at a previous Council meeting, that he thought he might have a conflict of interes
as a mamber of the Lodge Hill Committee and his role as Chairman of the Barish Council He undeter
