We are now nearly three months + into a public health crisis which affects us all. Current information suggests the "lockdown" should persist, for a further unspecified period, but Government messages have recently become quite ambiguous. It does look as though the Government has indicated that many places will begin to re-open this coming week, including some parts of Schools.

We would suggest that there is still a need for very careful self-management of social distancing and the wearing of masks in public places. The number of hospital CV-19 deaths has been "zero" for two days (as of May 31st) in West Sussex; this is not the time to let the virus take hold again.

This will be the last weekly Newsletter in this format. The Parish Magazine "The Link" will continue to carry news items on a monthly basis as usual. We would like to THANK everyone who has contributed to the communication and messenger process in the 12 weeks – 12 weeks – can you imagine it is that long?! Your time and efforts have contributed to keeping the statistics low and reducing the stress on NHS and local GPs and Pharmacies. The Labouring Man – what will the future bring? – has become something more than a "Pub", and we are all indebted to the service it has provided.

The "opening up" of the economy and communications does bring its downside. Bury Hill and Whiteways were "full" today – May 31^{st} – Bikers, walkers and cyclists. We cannot recommend this density of activity to be safe – please be careful.

The work of your Parish Council continues: we are very pleased to report the footpaths on the Brooks are better (if not perfect) due to the requests we have made to SWT, we now know that some of the footpaths have been flattened and made more accessible; there are still some that will be difficult and should be walked with care, especially on the river banks.

This is very important: We are receiving many reports of phone scams in the parish: please be aware. This 'vishing' or 'phishing' is very dangerous and easy to fall for. People claiming to represent well-known companies such as Amazon are contacting us with every appearance of reasonable professionalism and acting in our interests: they are not, they are dangerous, do not accept their calls or requests in any respect. Do not give out any personal details or information. We know of at least two residents who might have suffered serious financial loss, but for the prompt action of their bank. Do not respond to any telephone calls or emails that suggest either refunds or payments due.

<u>Please remember if you are making unnecessary journeys in your car you may be responsible for</u> <u>endangering the public health of us all.</u>

People are reminded that they should not struggle to use the steps but enter the PO directly while maintaining social distancing. Others are asked for understanding when this is necessary.

St James' School has remained open for children of Key Workers; it looks like preparations are in hand for some limited return to School, with effect from June 1st next week. The School will contact parents directly.

St James' School is looking forward to welcoming back pupils in the Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 from Monday June 1st. These pupils will be joining the children of Key Workers who have continued to attend at school throughout the lockdown period. Rigorous safety plans and risk assessments have been put in place by the staff team to enable a safe return to school for children, staff and parents. Parents have adapted remarkably well to home schooling and new technology has been embraced by staff to ensure quality learning experiences have been maintained; to see what the children have been learning during the lockdown, visit the class pages of the school's website.
