Difficult to know in terms of the planning but on a practical basis - that a condition is made that it should only be for personal use, especially if the facilities are sold then the new owners could change to make it a business, then there is a risk increase in traffic.

- The lane is very small with only one passing place, concern was raised about the transportation of the polo ponies to and from the site along the narrow lane using a large horsebox. The lane is used by horses and dog walkers.
- This would increase the development of a very rural area.
